Logan Elm Students Participate in Statewide Assessments

Logan Elm students in grades 3-12 are currently taking the statewide assessments, often referred to as "AIR Tests." For this year, the testing window, or time frame in which the assessments are given, is April 10-May 10, 2019.

Students in grades 3-8 take tests in English Language Arts and Math. Students in grades 5 and 8 also take Science tests. High School students take assessments in English Language Arts 1 & 2, Algebra 1 & Geometry, Biology, American History and Government.

The results of statewide assessments are used to generate data for the Local Report Cards issued to schools by the Ohio Department of Education. Individual student results will be mailed to parents in early August 2019.
