McDowell Artists move on to State Contest

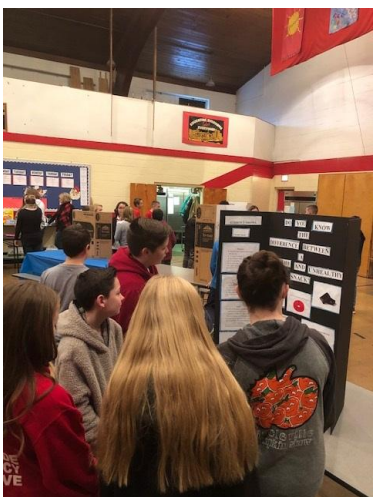
Eighth graders Aurora O'Phelan and Jude Schaal will

8th Grade students at McDowell Middle School in Mrs. Wilson's Math classes participated in a real-world, PBL (Problem Based Learning) project in conjunction with the Saving's Bank in Circleville. Representatives from the bank came to McDowell and spoke with the students about their annual Shred-It day and the costs associated with it. The students were tasked with coming up with a plan to cut cost by 20% to save the bank money. In groups, students researched ways to cut costs, devised their plans and created their presentations. The student groups then had the opportunity to present their plans to several different adults, including representatives from the Savings Bank.
