Please Note: Completing an application does not guarantee enrollment in Preschool. We must follow state and federal guidelines in giving priority for enrollment to students in qualifying categories.

For Students whose household income is below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, preschool tuition may be reduced (\$62.50 per month) or free.

In order to qualify for the ECE grant tuition waiver, parents must complete an ECE Screening Tool and provide proof of income at the time of screening and enrollment.

The Federal Poverty Level Income Chart for 2018 is listed below for reference. The 2019 Chart is expected to be released in February 2019.

200% of Federal Poverty Level Income Chart

For each additional family member, add \$8,640 at the 200% level.

Note: Programs must use the current year's poverty guidelines for any student enrolled after February 1.

In addition to income-based qualifications:

Students who are court-placed with someone other than their parents, under the jurisdiction of Job & Family Services, may also qualify for free tuition.

Students who have been identified as having a Disability attend preschool tuition free.
