Write how many syllables are in each name?</p>
<p><u>READING</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Define the roles of the author and the illustrator.</li><li>2. Tell someone the difference between fiction and nonfiction.</li></ol>	<p><u>SCIENCE</u></p> <p>Take a cup of water outside and record how long it takes to freeze.</p>	<p><u>MATH</u></p> <p>Go through your toys and sort your toys by color and size. (For example, small blue, large blue, small red, large red.) Which group had the most?</p>
